SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Participants and presenters must fill out the submission form. Participants do not **need** to submit a scientific work, while presenters must submit their scientific work in the form of a PPT, PDF, or web format.
- 2. The article review process will be conducted by **reviewers.** The review process is single-blind. Each manuscript is evaluated by two reviewers. The first stage involves screening for overall quality and relevance. A manuscript can only be considered for acceptance if it receives favorable recommendations from both reviewers.
- 3. Announcements will be sent to each participant via email based on the information provided in the submission form.
- 4. Participants and presenters are required to complete registration and payment through the details provided via email.
- 5. The committee will send the necessary documents to participants and presenters as required for their departure to South Korea.
- 6. The final announcement, containing an agreement notice between participants and presenters for the symposium, will be sent via email.
- 7. Information and inquiries can be addressed by listed contact person.

Due the requirements for participating International Symposium can be found by the following author guidelines below:

AUTHOR GUIDLINES

- 1. The paper topics must align with the scope of the symposium.
- 2. Submitted papers must be original research or literature reviews.
- 3. Papers must be written in English.
- 4. Plagiarism check has been conducted by the authors with a maximum similarity of 20%.
- 5. Papers must not have been published or accepted for publication in any other symposium.
- 6. Papers must not have been submitted to any other symposium for simultaneous publication or be under consideration for publication in any other event or purpose.
- 7. Presenter can be in the form of PowerPoint slides, policy briefs, research manuscripts, scientific articles, and other formats."

PRESENTER GUIDLINES

- Presenters are required to attend according to the schedule of the parallel sessions.
- 2. They must be arrive 5 minutes before the opening.
- 3. Each idea is to be presented by one presenter.
- 4. Late arrivals will be skipped, and the next presenter will present.
- 5. Presentation time is 10 minutes per presenter, with 6 presenters per session, followed by a 30 minute discussion.
- 6. Please use PowerPoint (.ppt or .pptx) or Portable Document Format (.pdf) for presentations.
- 7. The presentation should include the author's identity, introduction, methodology, results and discussion, and conclusion, with a maximum of 10 slides.
- 8. Presenters must presented their presentations in English.
